The health information you share with us is recorded in your medical record. Your medical record is a life-long history of your consultations, illnesses, health tests, prescriptions, and other treatments. This information is important for your care. Your record is also the story of your relationship with health care staff, doctors, nurses and others, over the years. This relationship is based on mutual trust and confidence and we will do everything we can to protect that trust.

We need to share your information with others involved in your treatment and care so that you can benefit from a wide range of expertise. Some of the information contained in your record may also be used for reasons other than your own health care - these reasons are vital to the running of the NHS.
